Let's kick things off with some key things that our software devs have been busy working on in recent weeks:

- Workflow: EMU just became about 30% faster. We've made a notable performance improvement and you'll be able to handle more faders than ever before on older machines.
- AU improvement: Fixed Logic Pro Audio Unit plugin support. Simply open the plugin manager in Logic Pro, select ENTTEC under manufacturer, press reset and rescan the selection.
- VST/AU improvement: Added PreSonus Studio One support.
- Added multiple RDM devices detection.
